



## Skills Needed for this Pattern

Abbreviation	Definition
K (K1)	<b>Knit</b> (Knit 1 stitch)
P (P1)	<b>Purl</b> (Purl 1 stitch) —
St(s)	Stitch(es)
Yo	<b>yarn over O</b>
K2tog	Knit 2 stitches together like one <math>\lt;/math>
SKP	<b>Slip, Knit, Pass.</b> Slip 1, Knit 1, Pass slipped stitch over the knit stitch. <math>\lt;/math>
beg	beginning
Rnd(s)	<b>Round(s)</b>
	Slip 2 sts to cable needle and hold in back, K2, K2 from cable needle. <math>\lt;/math>
	Slip stitch 1 to a cable needle and hold in back. Slip stitch 2 to another cable needle and hold in back. Knit stitch 3, knit stitch 2, then knit stitch 1. <math>\lt;/math>
	Slip stitch 1 to a cable needle and hold in front. Slip stitch 2 to another cable needle and hold in back. Knit stitch 3, knit stitch 2, then knit stitch 1. <math>\lt;/math>



## HiyaHiya Blossom Fingerless Mitts Knitting Pattern --- blossom\_ac17

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Designed by Qianer Huang (HiyaHiya)

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**These lovely fingerless mitts come pretty close to instant knitting gratification.**

**Size:** Woman's medium.

**Yarn:** 50 grams approximately 161 yards of fingering weight yarn

**Gauge:** 8 stitches\*10 rows=1 inch in cables stitch pattern

**Needle size: HiyaHiya Circular and Double Point Knitting Needles. US 1.5 (2.5mm)**

### Cables Stitch Pattern:

Rnds 1, 2, 3, 5, 6, 7, 9, 10, 11, \*P2, K3, P2, K1, P1, K4, P1, K1\*, Repeat from \* 4 times,

Rnd 4, \*P2, Slip stitch 1 to a cable needle and hold in back. Slip stitch 2 to another cable needle and hold in back. Knit stitch 3, knit stitch 2, then knit stitch 1, P2, K1, P1, Slip 2 sts to cable needle and hold in back, K2, K2 from cable needle, P1, K1\*, Repeat from \* 4 times,

Rnd 8, \*P2, Slip stitch 1 to a cable needle and hold in front. Slip stitch 2 to another cable needle and hold in back. Knit stitch 3, knit stitch 2, then knit stitch 1, P2, K1, P1, K4, P1, K1\*, Repeat from \* 4 times, Repeat Rnds 4-11.

### Blossom Stitch Pattern:

Rnd 1, \*P1, K1, Yo. K3, K2tog, K5\*, Repeat from \* 5 times,

Rnd 2, \*P1, K2, Yo, K2, K2tog, K5\*, Repeat from \* 5 times,

Rnd 3, \*P1, K3, Yo, K1, K2tog, K5\*, Repeat from \* 5 times,

Rnd 4, \*P1, K4, Yo, K2tog, K5\*, Repeat from \* 5 times,.

Rnd 5, \*P1, K5, SKP, K3, Yo, K1\*, Repeat from \* 5 times,

Rnd 6, \*P1, K5, SKP, K2, Yo, K2\*, Repeat from \* 5 times,

Rnd 7, \*P1, K5, SKP, K1, Yo, K3\*, Repeat from \* 5 times,

Rnd 8, \*P1, K5, SKP, Yo, K4\*, Repeat from \* 5 times.

Repeat Rnds 1-8.

### Mitts (make 2)

#### Left Hand,

Beg at top of Mitt, cast on 60 sts, with US 1.5 needles, depend on your choice of DPNs or a **9" or 11" circular**. **If your choice in two 9" or 11" circulars, please use one needle for the top stitches and another needle for the bottom stitches.** Place marker and join, being careful not to twist sts. Work in Cables Stitch Pattern for 2 in.(5 cm). Work in Blossom Stitch Pattern in the rnd until piece measures 5 in. (13 cm) from beg. Slip 12 sts to a stitch holder, continue knitting in Blossom Stitch Pattern until piece measures 6 in.(15.5cm) from beg.

#### Then knit Edge,

Rnds 1, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, \*K4, P2\*, Repeat from \* 8 times,

Rnd 2, \*Slip 2 sts to cable needle and hold in back, K2, K2 from cable needle, P2\*, Repeat from \* 8 times, Bind off loosely.

#### Thumb,

Carefully slip 12 sts from the stitch holder onto **US 1.5 DPNs** evenly. Attach yarn, with a second needle, pick up and k 4 sts in space between upper and lower needle---total 16 sts on a round, then work in \*K2, P2\* ribbing st 8 rnds. **Bind off loosely.**

#### Right Hand

Work as for Left Hand.

**FINISHING**, Steam block lightly if desired.
